- TAX YEAR 2021: Cook County Board of Review Hearings should be in July although the hearings have not yet been scheduled.
- No further word as to the estimated date of 2021 second installment Tax Bills.
- TAX YEAR 2022: Thus far no townships have been notified of their reassessment. During the last triennial (2019) the Assessor mailed the first reassessment notice on February 22, 2019 hence it appears that we are four months late for Tax Year 2022.
- ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: In light of the recent tornado and severe weather
 in the area I want to call to mind that there is a Natural Disaster Exemption
 available to victims of disasters such as the ones we have recently witnessed.
 Should we experience an unfortunate event our office will be ready to provide
 assistance in applying for this exemption.
