

DISASTER DECLARATION

Unincorporated Cook County, Wheeling Township has suffered from river and storm water flooding that occurred on September 13, 14, 15, & 16, 2008 causing severe damage to public and private property, disruption of utility service and endangerment of health and safety of the citizens of Unincorporated Wheeling Township.

Therefore, Scott G. Saewert, Highway Commissioner, has declared a state of emergency authorized under local ordinance and Illinois State Statute on behalf of Unincorporated Wheeling Township, and will execute for and on behalf of Unincorporated Wheeling Township, to coordinate the necessary response and recovery activities necessary to bring said disaster to a rapid conclusion for the best interest of the residents of Unincorporated Wheeling Township, Cook County, Illinois pursuant to the Cook County Emergency Management Agency Ordinance as amended, and the Illinois Emergency Management Act (20ILCS3305) as amended.

This proclamation shall be filed with the Wheeling Township Clerk and shall expire after 7 days unless terminated sooner by me as principle executive officer of Unincorporated Wheeling Township or unless extended as required by local ordinance.
